Level 1 Qualification in Sports Leadership Information and Guidance

Chapter 1 has been delivering the Level 1 Qualification in Sports Leadership to people aged 19+ in Manchester since 2010. The course is accredited by Sports Leaders UK, a national organisation helping people to build skills, motivation and confidence through sports.

During the Sports Leadership course learners participate in a variety of sports and activities including squash, kickboxing, football, rugby, handball and badminton. The course covers the following areas over 6 sessions:

- Planning, leading and reviewing a sport/activity
- Developing leadership skills
- Leading activities that promote a healthy lifestyle
- Fair play in sport
- The role of the official
- Opportunities in sport and recreation

Learners are assessed through a portfolio, participation and contribution, as well as a practical final assessment on the last day of the course.

Our experienced team are dedicated to delivering a quality service to all learners. We are committed to helping learners to progress and can offer information, advice and guidance on further learning and training opportunities.

- Please include as much information as possible on the referral form. This allows us to provide appropriate support to learners.
- Due to funding requirements we can only accept referrals for learners aged 19+.
- We require learners to have at least **ESOL Entry 2** in order to complete the programme.
- Unfortunately we cannot currently offer childcare, and the nature of our facilities means that learners will not be able to bring children with them to the programme.
- We aim to keep the named contact from the referring agency informed at all stages of the process.
- Additionally we expect the named contact or learner to inform us of any changes in circumstance – someone on the waiting list could be offered a place, so if a learner cannot attend please inform the Manager as soon as possible.
- It is important that the learner is willing to engage with us if they want to successfully complete the programme.
- If you are aware that a learner may not be available at certain times please include this on the 'Availability' section of the form.
- Referring agencies may need to be involved and able to support learners to successfully access our service and be involved in the completion of the course.
- The risk assessment must be completed by a **professional person**, who has known the learner for a **minimum of 3 months**. This person must also provide their contact details.
- Incomplete referrals may delay learners being accepted – we need to be able to get in touch with learners before and during the course, so please ensure that contact details are up to date.
